Metered spaces in the Pendleton Street Garage are available to you when you wish to visit the Regional Campuses Office. You may secure an all day parking sticker for the garage for \$1.00 from the Vehicle Registration Office on the Pendleton Street level of the garage. Parking fees may be reimbursed on travel vouchers. Fines and towing fees may not. Transportation from the Regional Campuses Office to any other office may be secured by calling the Campus Taxi Service or using one of their two vehicles when they are available.

COLLEGE-OWNED EQUIPMENT NOT TO BE TAKEN HOME

College faculty and staff are reminded that college-owned equipment may not be taken to their homes. There may be times where it will be necessary to use equipment off campus at other normal working hours. In these cases, if it is not practical to return the equipment to the locked college building where the item is normally stored, college employees are directed to store the item with the security guard in the back trailor beside the Administration Building or with Paul Braunbeck at the Custodial House.
