MR. JACK DANIEL'S ORIGINAL SILVER CORNET BAND TO PERFORM AT WHEELWRIGHT AUDITORIUM

The Jack Daniel's Original Silver Cornet Band will make its first appearance in Wheelwright Auditorium, when the national touring group brings its popularly acclaimed show to USC-Coastal Carolina College on Friday and Saturday, March 26-27.

Mr. Jack Daniel's Original Silver Cornet Band was first formed in 1982 in Lynchburg, Tennessee. Mr. Jack Daniel bought \$227.00 worth of instruments from the Sears Catalog, so that his town could have a community band as did thousands of other small towns at the turn of the century. For some twenty odd years, the band performed in the Lynchburg area.

Today's version of the famous band still comes out of Tennessee, where all the members are accomplished recording studio musicians.

The band was re-established in the early 1970's when Dave Fulmer, actor-musician-historian, became intrigued by an old photograph of the original band. He obtained authentic reproductions of the instruments, revived and revitalized the old scores, found the musicians and wrapped the whole package in an entertaining and nostalgic stage production. The result was a delightful evening of music and theatre, focused upon a gazebo, a thirteen piece small town band, and a yarn-spinning Perfesser/Conductor.

NINE USC CAMPUSES PRODUCE ARTS FESTIVAL AT COASTAL

Performing artists from all nine University of South Carolina campuses will converge on USC-Coastal Carolina College March 31 for the annual three-day Spring Arts Festival hosted by Coastal Carolina College, the USC campus located between Myrtle Beach and Conway.

Spring Arts Festival '82, the fourth spring arts celebration at the college, will feature more than 20 events including art exhibits, musical performances, theatrical productions, folk dancing and a film festival.

"This year's Spring Arts Festival will include 10 musical events, plays, pupper shows and motion pictures," says Dr. Carol Schramm, the Coastal Carolina College professor who is festival chairman. "The USC Symphony, an 80-piece group, will perform and so will groups from all the other University campuses. The festival is free to everyone and events are appropriate for children, especially the events scheduled for mornings."

The festival begins with an opening night on Wednesday, March 31, and will continue all day Thursday and Friday, April 1 and 2. Most of the Coastal Carolina College campus is reserved for festival events, which include:
