COLLEGE SPONSORS COMMUNICATIONS SEMINAR

The Office of Continuing Education at USC-Coastal Carolina College is sponsoring a seminar on effective business and personal communications. Entitled "Creative Communication Seminar," the workshop is designed to teach participants how to effectively communicate with friends, associates, business contacts and other relationships which require competent communications.

The seminar is scheduled for November 19, 9 a.m. 4:30 p.m., with registration at 8:30 a.m. The workshop will be held in room 205 of the Student Center at USC-Coastal Carolina College, which is located off U.S. 501 between Myrtle Beach and Conway. Registration is \$60 per person and includes materials and refreshments. A 10 per cent discount is offered to firms or organizations which enroll three or more persons in the seminar.

The seminar instructor is Dr. Hilda Lee Dail, a New York-based communications consultant who has developed sales and communication techniques for numerous American businesses and corporations.

"This seminar will teach you how to create a climate of trust with another person," she says, "which is central to developing effective communication. Participants in this one-day program will learn the technology of communication which will help identify and dissolve barriers, so communication can become spontaneous and natural. That's good for personal relationships. It's good for business. It's good for life."
