The Coastal Carolina Concert Choir will present two public concerts of Christmas music in Myrtle Beach and Conway on Dec. 7 and Dec. 10.

FACULTY/STAFF DEPENDENTS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The University of South Carolina Educational Foundation annually makes a sum of money available to be utilized for awarding scholarships to dependents of University employees. The policies governing this program are as follows:

- (1) Available to dependents of full time slotted University of South Carolina system employees, with priority given to dependent children. At the discretion of the University Scholarship and Financial Aid Committee, consideration may be given to the spouses of University employees.
- (2) The applicant(s) must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as an undergraduate on a full-time basis at one of the University's nine campuses.
- (3) Must have 3.0 predicted GPR for freshmen, 3.5 cummulative GPR for first-time upperclassmen.
- (4) The scholarship shall be designated annually on the basis of available funds.
- (5) Applications must be submitted to the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships on the Columbia campus no later than February 15, 1983. Application forms are available at the Financial Aid Office on each of the campuses.
