#### SPRING ARTS FESTIVAL TO FEATURE MUSIC

If you enjoy music, you'll enjoy the 1983 Spring Arts Festival at USC-Coastal Carolina College, say festival organizers. The Fifth Annual Coastal Carolina College Spring Arts Festival, scheduled for April 6-9 at the college, includes a wide variety of musical performances.

Mixed in with the art shows, food booths, crafts and dancing, festival planners have scheduled musical events ranging from opera to country music. "We're trying to offer something musical for almost everyone's taste," explains Dr. Carol Schramm, an Assistant Professor of Music at Coastal and a member of the festival committee. "There will be an impressive array of musical talent assembled on the campus during the festival," she says, "and we hope that music lovers in the area will enjoy the variety of performances. It's sort of a present from the college to the community."

The festival officially begins at 8 p.m., Wednesday, April 6, with a free public address by syndicated columnist James J. Kilpatrick, who is appearing in Wheelwright Auditorium as part of the William A. Kimbel Distinguished Lecture Series. The festival begins in full at 9 a.m. Thursday and continues on an all-day schedule on Friday and Saturday, April 8-9.

The first musical performance is at 10 a.m. Thursday, when the Potpourri of American Musical Theater is presented in Wheelwright Auditorium. At 10:30 Thursday morning, musical excerpts from <u>Cinderella</u> will be performed by Gregg Goodson of the Upstage Company in the Little Theatre of Coastal's Fine Arts Building. At noon on Thursday, Coastal Carolina College folklorist Dr. Charles Joyner will perform a recital of folk music in the Little Theatre; at 12:20 an "Opera Sampler" is scheduled for Wheelwright Auditorium and 1 p.m., a jazz dance will be performed at the International Taverna in room 102 of the Student Center.

On Friday, April 8, excerpts from <u>Cinderella</u> will be repeated at 9:30 a.m. in the Little Theatre of the Fine Arts Building. At 11 a.m., the University of South Carolina Left Bank Jazz Ensemble will perform in Wheelwright Auditorium. At 12:30 p.m., the Coastal Carolina College Concert Choir, under the direction of Carolyn Cox, will perform in Wheelwright Auditorium.

the finale of the festival, Saturday, April 9, the On Brass Ouintet, directed by Marsh Myers, will perform at 9:30 a.m. under the gazebo of Spadoni Park, in front of Wheelwright Auditorium. At 11 a.m., Robert Pruzin of USC-Columbia, accompanied by Charles Fugo on piano, will perform a French horn recital in Wheelwright Auditorium. At noon, the Coastal Carolina Stage Band, directed by Dale Orris will perform on the front terrace of the Fine Arts Building; at 1 p.m., Carson and Judy Lowe will perform country and westernmint music on the Fine Arts Building terrace; at 2:15 jazz dance will be repeated in room 102 of the Student Center and at 3:30 p.m. violinist John Bauer of USC-Columbia, cellist Lucien DeGroote of USC-Columbia and pianist Vola Jacobs of Augusta College will perform a musical recital of violin, cello and piano in Wheelwright Auditorium.

The musical performances, arts, crafts, theater, philosophy symposium and other events of the 1983 Spring Arts Festival are free and open to the public.

#### MIME GROUP PERFORMS AT COASTAL APRIL 7

The United Mime Workers will perform at 8 p.m., Thursday, April 7, in Wheelwright Auditorium at USC-Coastal Carolina College. The performance is the final event of the 1983 Cultural Arts Series at the college.

The United Mime Workers is a collective of composerperformers who perform in mime throughout the nation and in Europe. Since 1971, the group has performed and taught in theaters, universities, schools, prisons, parks, community centers and union halls in several countries.

Using mime, they compose intricate structures and movement scores to explore the social conventions that determine daily lives. They also connect the form and content of human labor with other disciplines and draw from daily life in the tradition of silent comedy.

The Cultural Arts Series at USC-Coastal Carolina College is made possible in part by grants from the National Endowment fot the Arts, the Horry County Higher Education Commission, the Coastal Educational Foundation and Coastal Carolina College.

Admission to the April 7 performance is \$5 at the door for patrons who do not have season tickets.

#### NOMINATIONS FOR **GEORGE C. ROGERS AWARD REOPENED**

The Student Affairs Committee has decided to re-open nominations for the 1983 George C. Rogers Service Award. The recipient is selected from campus-wide nominations for eventual campus voting.

The criteria for this award include: a currently enrolled student - Junior or Senior status, cumulative service at the College and service in all areas of the College Community. There is no restriction as to Grade Point Average.

The nominated student should be asked to compile his/ her record of campus and community service since this record will be the only document considered by the Committee. The completed nomination should be signed by both the student nominated and the person making the nomination.

The new deadline for receipt of nominations is April 5, 1983 to the Office of the Dean of Students in the Student Center, Room 206.

The names of the two students already nominated, Robert McCray and J. Todd MacNeir, will appear on the campus ballot for re-voting. New ballots will be distributed on April 6, 1983.

#### **LIBRARY BOOK SALE APRIL 7-9**

The library will be sponsoring a bargain book sale in front of the building during the Spring Arts Festival, April 7, 8 & 9. Items will be priced from 50 cents to \$3.00. Donated books will be the feature of the sale; the library is not permitted to sell volumes originally in the collection if they were purchased with state funds.

These books should be forwarded to Charmaine Tomczyk by Wednesday, March 30, and the batch should be identified by the donor's name. We cannot give letters of receipt for these items, since it will be impossible to keep track of which ones sell. but your help is appreciated.
