The editor of this magazine chose these two documents in hopes that making this information available to the readers of the *Independent Republic Quarterly* will help us all to better understand the history of our county in the 1850s.

By studying this document, hopefully you will realize how wide spread slavery was in Horry County in the 1850s. My students and myself found it interesting how it was not only male farmers who owned slaves, but town dwellers, women and even a black man (William Burgess) owned slaves.
