Paul Olsen and **Ken Townsend** will be heading to Afghanistan July 14 to be embedded with Alan Case's National Guard unit there. Olsen will take photographs, and Townsend will write an article for inclusion in the fall/winter Coastal Carolina University magazine. This unique opportunity developed through conversations between Eddie Dyer and Case, a major in the South Carolina National Guard who is serving his second tour of duty in Afghanistan. When Case informed him about the possibility of faculty members being embedded with his unit this summer as part of a Pentagon-sponsored tour, Dyer asked Townsend, who is Coastal's military historian, and Olsen, photography instructor and a major in the Army Reserves, if they were interested. Both were eager to participate, and Case began working on logistics. Olsen and Townsend will return July 30, and Case will finish his tour of duty in mid-August.
