TORNADO SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Tornado Watch: Broadcast over Radio-TV: Continue normal activities, be alert to weather outside, and stay near a radio or television set to hear further bulletins and any tornado warnings.
- Tornado Warning: Tornado is approaching, or has struck the area.
- What To Do When Tornado Warning Is Received: Go to basement if available. If no basement, but building is of reinforced construction, stay indoors and away from windows. When practicable go to an interior hallway on the lowest floor. Avoid auditoriums and gmynasiums with large poorly supported roofs.

- In Building Of Light Construction: Go quickly to a reinforced building or to a ravine or open ditch and lie flat.
- In Open Country: Move away from the tornado's path at a right angle. If no time to escape, lie flat in the nearest depression, ditch or ravine.
- Keep Listening: Your radio-television stations will broadcast the latest tornado advisories.
 Call the Weather Bureau only to report a tornado.
- All Clear: Issued by the Weather Bureau only and announced by Radio or TV.
