REGISTRATION

USC Coastal Carolina College late registration begins January 9 and continues through January 14, the day classes begin. Times are 9 a.m. - 11 a.m., and 1 p.m. - 4 p.m. to follow the times listed in the "Schedule of Classes, Spring Sessions" guidelines. Graduate school admissions will be from 3 - 7 p.m. January 8 at the college. People wishing to apply to the college are asked to do so before January 9 so that they may be processed more rapidly.

LITERATURE THROUGH TRAVEL
