STUDENTS TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES BY APPOINTMENT

USC Coastal Carolina College students will register by appointment for the first time this fall. The new procedure was designed to reduce waiting times and to give students more individual attention, said Marsh Myers, registrar at the college.

Appointment cards will be mailed to students who were admitted to the college before Aug. 1. Students admitted to the college after Aug. 1 will receive their appointment cards with their acceptance letters. The appointment cards will be used for fee payment and drop/add, as well as registration.

"Students can register after their appointment time, but will be unable to register prior to their time," said Lindy Smith, assistant registrar at USC Coastal Carolina College. "All students are encouraged to keep their scheduled time."

Graduate students who are continuing at the college are to register from 4 p.m. - 6:15 p.m. Monday, Aug. 26. New graduate students will register from 4 p.m. - 6:15 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 27.

'COLLEGE AFTER 25' PROGRAM SCHEDULED

The award winning 'College After 25' program will be held Aug. 6 at USC Coastal Carolina College's campus, and again on Aug. 8 at the Georgetown Extension.

The program helps adults understand the admissions process, how to apply for financial assistance, where to find help for career decisions and special concerns and issues for adult students.
