On Wednesday, July 16, all non-academic room reservations for fall 2008 (Aug.1 to Dec. 31) were lost during a system malfunction. The Office of Conference Services is re-entering the reservations as quickly as possible (from hard-copy records) and sending new reservation confirmations. This process started last week, and some of you may have already received new confirmations for reservations you have previously made. Please note that your original confirmation numbers are no longer valid; new room reservation confirmations will be assigned a new confirmation number by the system. At this time you do not need to call the Conference Services Office to confirm your fall reservations. When re-entering the reservations is complete, the campus will be notified. At that time anyone who has not received a new confirmation will be asked to contact Conference Services.
