Facilities Management warns that during this week (Aug. 4 to 8), inspection crews from Grand Strand Water & Sewer Authority will conduct a physical survey of the sanitary sewer system in our area. This study will involve the opening and entering of manholes in the streets and easements. The survey will be the "Smoke Testing" of the sewer lines to locate breaks and defects in the sewer system. If you should see any smoke coming from vents or holes in the ground, do not be concerned as the smoke is nontoxic, nonstaining, leaves no residue, has no odor and creates no fire hazard.
