## SASSER NAMED ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

East Tennessee State University Director of Athletics George F. "Buddy" Sasser has been named athletic director for USC Coastal Carolina College. The appointment was announced by Chancellor Ron Eaglin during a news conference at the college Wednesday morning.

"As athletic director," Dr. Eaglin said, "Buddy will be in a position to shape the future of athletics at Coastal Carolina College. We will look to his experience and expertise to lead us as we move to NCAA Division I. His commitment to athletics as well as academics will play an integral part in this college's commitment to overall excellence."

A native of Conway, Sasser served as athletic director and head football coach at Conway High School early in his career, from 1963 to 1970. He was also assistant football coach and head baseball coach at Conway from 1960 to 1963. He has been with East Tennessee State since 1982, as head football coach for the first three years and as director of athletics since 1985. He also served as athletic director and head football coach at Wofford College for six years, from 1977 to 1982, and as assistant football coach and assistant athletic director at Appalachian State University for five years, from 1972 to 1977.

As athletic director at Coastal, Sasser will be responsible for managing the athletic programs as well as directing athletic fund-raising and promotion.

Throughout his career Sasser has

received numerous awards for his accomplishments in sports and community service including being named "AAA" Football Coach of the Year in South Carolina. He has been active in organizations such as Kiwanis, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, March of Dimes, and Heart Fund.

Sasser graduated from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 1958 where he lettered in football three years. He received his master's degree in education and administration from the University of South Carolina in 1960.

## EXERCISE CAUTION AS WORK CONTINUES ON EXTERIORS OF CAMPUS BUILDINGS
