o **Dr. Tim Touzel**, associate professor elementary education, recently completed judging the Educational Testing Service's new "Professional Knowledge Examination" which will be given to all South Carolina education majors as they exit their program of studies. Beginning in 1988 certification for teaching will require students to pass several formal tests: student teaching (APT), a content test in their major, and the new "Professional Knowledge Examination." Earlier this semester Touzel also finished work on the new "Program Evaluation Standards" used to accredit education programs in the state of

South Carolina. He helped edit the glossary for this.
