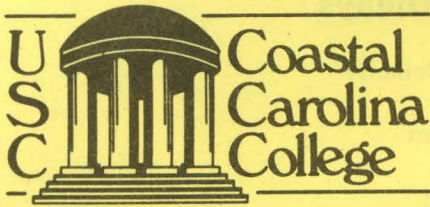

There will be no reserved parking for faculty and staff for the 1987-88 academic year. Adequate parking will be available with the addition of faculty/staff spaces behind the academic building, and the enforcement of parking restrictions in the former faculty/staff area near the security building.

To help relieve congestion in all campus lots, students who wish to register and park free may obtain a special sticker that is valid only for the baseball field parking lot. It is anticipated that this policy will encourage students to use the overflow area which will accommodate approximately 350 cars.
