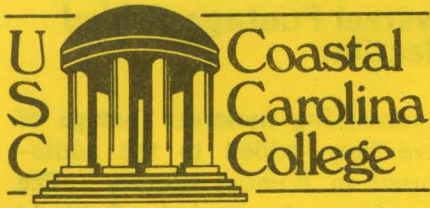

Education Scholarship Established For 1987-88 Academic Year

The School of Education and Health Professions of USC Coastal Carolina College announces the establishment of the Pelican Company Education Scholarship program for the 1987-88 academic year. The Pelican Company Education Scholarships are directed toward both graduate and undergraduate study in the field of education. Two graduate scholarships will be awarded for graduate study in the field of education at Coastal Carolina. The Pelican Company Teacher Cadet Scholarship will be awarded to students participating in the Teacher Cadet Program in the Horry County School District.

Two graduate scholarships at \$500 each are now available to assist teachers in advanced study in education at Coastal's campus. Scholarship recipients must be currently teaching in the Horry County School District and have, through previous graduate study, established a grade point average of no less than 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Additionally, scholarship money must be used to support the teacher's professional development in an area which will enhance his/her instructional effectiveness.

Scholarships available for the support of undergraduate study are directed toward students participating in the Teacher Cadet Program, a specialized, high-school based program established to encourage students who have excelled academically to consider the field of teaching as a viable career choice.

Qualified applicants for either of these scholarship programs should contact the office of the School of Education and Health Professions at Coastal. The deadline for applications is Friday, September 18, 1987.

As their friendship grows, so does Buddy's trust towards C.C.; and in the climactic scene of the play, the boy dies just as he is about to free himself from his greatest fear.
