The tournament will be open to both men and women with a shotgun start at 9 a.m. During the tournament, non-golfers can enjoy a tour, conducted by Professor Michie, of the several archaeological sites at Wachesaw. Immediately following golf, there will be a buffet and awards ceremony on the riverfront deck at Kimbel's.
