Chairman Gene Spivey brought the meeting to order at 11:06 a.m.

Jason Repak moved to approve the Oct. 22, 2020, Athletics Committee meeting minutes. John Bartell seconded, and the motion carried.

Kelly Moore, Executive Director, Chanticleer Athletic Foundation, gave a Chanticleer Athletic Foundation (CAF) report.

- CAF has raised \$1.45 million through Jan. 31, 2021.
- Pending COVID-19 restrictions and guidelines, the Chanticleer Gala is planned for May 22, 2021, at the Marriott Myrtle Beach Resort & Spa at Grande Dunes.
- Construction on the east-side gates of Brooks Stadium is planned to begin after spring commencement.
- Due to COVID-19 guidelines for baseball, the University has changed the inside of the Jerrett Zone. This will now be where you can get your concessions then head to your assigned seats.

- The Chanticleer Connection newsletter has gone out to the community to share foundation updates and how CAF can connect people with the University's athletic department.
- The CAF Board of Director's meeting will be held on May 12, 2021.

Matthew Hogue, Director of Athletics, gave a general sports update.

- Coastal Carolina University football was ranked number one in the Sun Belt Commission Cup.
- Men's and women's basketball teams are on track towards the Sun Belt Tournament.
- The men's golf team recently won at Kiawah, and the women's team won the Hilton Head tournament.
- Jermaisha Arnold and Melissa Jefferson have been named Sun Belt Indoor Track Athlete of the Week.
- Due to the University's recent successful football season:
 - Coastal eventually reached 58.65 million media mentions from November 30, 2020 through January 1, 2021;
 - There was a 78% positive change in social media followers for Coastal Carolina University in FBS football in the past year; and
